# College – study notes

- only undergraduated, 4 years for Bc.
- all in greek language (with comments of mates and translation of teacher afterwards)
- Musculo-skeletal (Maitland) & Neuro (NDT) program
  - laboratory - practical training at college (2 hours)
  - practice – hospital orthopedia, CP home, primary school for children with disabilities
  - (theory) – attendance is meaningless
- Course curriculum is not update in web

# College

- Final exam – practical in hospital + essays,  
– 21 ECTS
  - „A“ 4 ECTS - Praktická cvičení z fyzioterapie IV
  - „C“ 17 ECTS

- Greek language course
  - for free, about grammatics
  - 2 hours / week



- Travelling to department
  - by bus from Patra – 2x1 hour, 2x2 euro ... 2x week

# Accommodation and food

- Patra – city with life and students, student house close to canteen (rent 200 E/month)
- Aigio – small town, around 200 physio students live there, lower rents (150E)
- Food is for free in canteens (Patra and Aigio), 3x day
  - choice from 4 dishes (vege menu)
  - salads, bread, fruit
  - quality is equal to usual Czech canteen...



# Erasmus life

- TEI Erasmus mundus, from all the world
  - 7 Indians, 1 Slovene, 1 Romanian
- Uni of Patras, big university with many Erasmus students
  - ESN program – parties and trips



# Something from real life...

- Students don't share flats together, usually live alone or with siblings
- Public transport is unpredictable and buses change ways sometimes. No names of stations, no timetables, no worries.
- English level is similar to our country
- Emergency is for free
- Sea in Patra is dirty, but just a bit far is perfect
- Fruit and vegetable is full of taste and cheap
- Party never begins before midnight
- Travelling can be very cheap, including islands
- Aigio – Patra takes long time (from student house over 1,5 hour), but sea view never begins to pall
- Expenses – Erasmus scholarship + my normal expenses, and I travelled a lot in lowcost way and buy local food
- 2 weeks of holiday in time of orthodox Easters (beginning of May)
- It is normal that people are sitting, staring to nowhere and drinking coffee
- People smoke a lot even in college corridors
- Almost no refugees in this area
