



**Admissions – Entrance examinations at FHS UP for the 2026/2027
Academic Year:**

Bachelor's study programme: Physiotherapy

1. Application submission deadline: 31 July 2026

The application is submitted in an electronic form, and applicants must pay the administration fee and upload attachments proving that they meet the necessary requirements.

2. Application fee:

The fee of EUR 60 or its equivalent in the respective currency is to be paid by the applicant or an agency which has a contractual relationship with the Faculty of Health Sciences UP or UP.

Payment details are stipulated in the electronic application

The application fee is non-refundable.

3. Documents and admission requirements:

- a) Proof of completed secondary or higher education or current study in the last year of secondary school. The original document or its certified copy, proving the completion of secondary education, must be submitted no later than 30 September 2026.
- b) Letter of motivation
- c) Passport – a photocopy of a page with the photograph
- d) One of the internationally recognised English language proficiency tests proving a minimum B1 level according to CEFR: PET/FCE Cambridge exam, BULATS score 60, IELTS 5 (min. 4 from each part), or TOEFL iBT – 40 or an equivalent test. Native speakers or non-native speakers who present evidence of completed education in the English language do not have to submit the international test results.
- e) In case the applicant is unable to provide proof of English proficiency according to the above-stated conditions, they have the possibility of taking an online English proficiency test by the UP Faculty of Health Sciences. The language test contains 50 multiple-choice questions. The result is then converted to a percentage. The minimum passing criteria is 50% of correct answers. The language test result is not part of the total score.
- f) Written test from Human Biology and Natural Science contains multiple choice questions which are evaluated with one point given for each correctly answered test question, and the result is converted into a percentage. The minimum passing criteria is 55% as a total result for the two subject tests.
- g) Online interview – the applicant will be invited to an online interview, dependent on meeting the conditions in 3 a) – f). The interview will evaluate the motivation of the student for studying PT at Palacký University and assess their level of spoken English and comprehension. It is

assessed as “pass” or “fail”, and the applicant can be given up to 30 points. A “pass” result from the interview is one of the conditions for an overall “pass” result of the entrance exam.

4. Maximum number of applicants accepted: 18

5. Exact dates for the Entrance Exams:

Entrance examinations can be held from 01 January 2026 to 31 August 2026.

6. Invitation for the entrance examination

Applicants/cooperating agencies will be sent invitations to take the entrance examination, provided that a complete application was submitted on time. The invitation will contain detailed information regarding the entrance examination (date, time, platform).
