

ANNUAL REPORT GUIDE

At the end of an academic year, the doctoral student submits their Annual Report and related documents to the Student Affairs Office. The submission deadline is the deadline for completion of study obligations of the given academic year.

The Annual Report includes:

ANNUAL REPORT FORM

The Annual Report form can be downloaded from the website of the relevant doctoral programme.

Fill in the form, sign it and give it to your supervisor for evaluation. Submit the completed form to the Student

Affairs Office by the end of August.

PUBLICATIONS SUMMARY (OBD)

Read carefully the guideline on Uploading and registering publications on the DSP website.

Print the publication summary from the OBD website or contact the department secretary to print it and submit it with the Annual Report.

CONFERENCE PRESENTATION

Together with the Pre-exam Report, submit the **certificate** of participation, **abstract** of the presented paper and conference **program**.

If the conference includes a book of abstract, include the title page of the book, its content and the abstract or the full text in published

form.

PUBLICATIONS

If it is an **article**:

To the Pre-exam

Report, please include the published **article**, **title page** of the journal (or the title web-page), and the extract from the **OBD**.

&

If it is a **book**:

Include the **title page** of the publication, **content**, the **full text** (e.g. a chapter), and the extract from **OBD**.

PROJECTS

Submitted project:

Submit the Preexam Report, the complete **project proposal** and the **confirmation of project submission**.

Completed project:

Report with the confirmation of project submission and the project final report confirming the project's completion.

EXAM / PRE-EXAM REPORTS

The completion of each course must be confirmed by the submitted **Pre-exam/Exam Report**. The form is for **download** on the website of the relevant doctoral programme.

&

Submit the filled in report to the course teacher/guarantor for signature. The teacher/guarantor can be found in the course syllabus in STAG.
