Czech Government measures valid from April 12, 2021

Please keep on your mind that the purpose of all measures is to prevent the spreading of the virus. The epidemic situation in the Czech Republic is getting better compared to the past weeks, but the numbers are still high considering the number of PCR tests taken per day and the number of people in hospitals, last but not least cases of virus mutation have started to appear.

From April 12, 2021:

- A ban on movement between districts ended. No document/declaration is required when travelling within the territory of the CR.
 - Curfew between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. ended (note that at 10 p.m. all shops and selling places must be closed).
 - Wearing respirators practically everywhere (in all places with a higher concentration of people) and social distancing (only two people can gather, if more, they should be of one household) remain required.
 - Shops and services that are not essential stay closed. Newly e.g. dry cleaners, shops selling stuff for kids are open, stationeries are open.
 - It is not possible to travel to countries with an extreme risk of COVID-19 transmission. This travel ban applies to the Czech citizens and foreigners living in the territory of the Czech Republic (source: https://www.mvcr.cz/mvcren/article/coronavirus-information-of-moi.aspx), prolonged to May 31, 2021.
 - Sports grounds should be open for use. There is a limit for the number of people who can join activities there (12 people max).
 - (Adults are not allowed to perform any outdoor activities at sports grounds for children. Grounds in the Neředín residence area are private places for children in the residence area. People who do not live in the residential buildings are not allowed to visit them!)
 - Students who need to go for antigen tests regularly because of their practical training can take the antigen test for free twice a week. They need to show the registration of the EHIC (provide the personal number of the insured person in the CR written in the document received from the Czech insurance company (VZP). If you are an EU student in need to arrange/prolong the registration, send a copy of the valid EHIC to zuzana.hamdanieh@upol.cz. If you rely on commercial insurance, check the conditions.
