Environmental and socio-economic determinants of health are closely interlinked. Socio-economic determinants are functions of the circumstances in which people live, work and grow; largely shaped by the distribution of resources and power.

Environmental improvements for health can make important contributions towards achieving the Sustainable Development Goals. Exposure to environmental risk factors is unequally distributed, and this unequal distribution is often related to socio-economic characteristics such as income, social status, employment and education, but also noneconomic aspects such as gender, age and ethnicity.

The costs and benefits of prevention through healthier environments are important. Avoided treatment costs and other externalities caused unhealthy by environments should be accounted for.

The research will be focused on links between the environmental and socio-economic determinants of health. Current environmental and climate policy instruments will be observed and evaluate. Regional differences and localisation aspects will be incorporated.

WHO ARE WE SEARCHING FOR?

Potential candidates need to hold a doctoral degree (Ph.D.) not longer than 8 years and have not resided in the Czech Republic for more than 12 months during the last 3 years, at the time of the deadline.
