



Checking the Course of Study for the Academic Year 2024/2025

The deadline for the completion of study requirements for the academic year 2024/2025 is

5th September 2025

By this date, students are required to finish their courses and receive a minimum of 40 credits in order to pass to the next academic year. After the completion of exams, log into STAG, go to the section Course of Study and click on “Check results and register for the academic year 2025/2026”. Then tick off the “I confirm I have checked the Registration form A” (found below on the STAG page). By confirming, the student confirms he/she agrees with the data in STAG and will register again for any unfinished courses again in the next academic year.
